

PLANT CARE

POTTED BULB GARDENS

LIGHT

Place in bright, indirect sunlight. Remember to rotate your plant periodically to allow for even light distribution.

TEMPERATURE

Keep at room temperature (65-80° F) until bulbs begin to root and the leaves and flower stalks begin to grow. When in flower, cooler temperatures will prolong bloom duration. Keep away from drafts and vents for best growth.

WATERING

Upon receipt, water your garden thoroughly and maintain moderate moisture levels throughout your garden's growth and flowering. If your planted container garden does not have drainage, water sparingly.

TIPS

When flowers fade, cut back flowering stalks to just above the top of the bulb but leave emerging leaves to grow. Most perennial bulbs can be planted outdoors after danger of frost has past.
