

PLANT CARE

SUCCULENTS

Drought tolerant, succulents make for hardy living gifts to use both indoors and out.

LIGHT

Succulents grown outside thrive in the full to partial sun. Succulents grown inside should be placed near a south-facing window indoors.

TEMPERATURE

Succulents grow best at temperatures above 72°F and are tolerant of high heat. Bring inside when temperatures drop below 55°F.

WATERING

Though drought tolerant, succulents grow best with regular watering and fertilizing. Water when soil becomes dry to 1" below the surface. Feed with a light strength, well balanced fertilizer once a month.

TIPS

If the plant begins to develop space between its leaves along the stem, it is not receiving enough light. Do not allow plant to sit in standing water.
